This three-year-old **online journal** is distributed **at no charge** to almost 100,000 people all over the world. It is published by the Hektoen Institute of Medicine with the purpose of exposing healthcare professionals to **art, ethics, education, literature, medical history, and poetry** as they relate to medicine.

Hektoen International is read by doctors, nurses, therapists, pharmacists, social workers, technicians, students, and patients. It features articles on the medical humanities from a variety of authors from all four continents, but does not publish clinical studies. In its short existence the journal has received wide acclaim.

Correspondents from many countries have commented that indeed there is a great need for this kind of journal.

The journal is divided into four sections: new published **articles**; the **gallery**, a repository of artwork on medical themes; a **library** serving as an archive for documents and articles on a variety of subjects; and a section on **links** to many other relevant sites and organizations.
